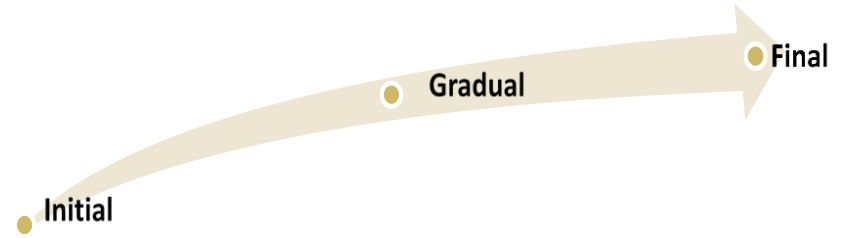


# 2 CORINTHIANS: POWER THROUGH WEAKNESS
